The following dog/bitch puppy of the Golden Retriever breed has been sold to the person(s) listed above as the Purchaser and Sherri Hall as the breeder.

Your puppy is sold to you as a healthy, happy puppy of sound temperament. He/she is the result of selective mating of quality parents with certified clearances. He/she is an excellent representative of the breed. The buyer agrees to take good and responsible care of the dog, providing adequate nutrition, shelter and medical care including annual examinations so as to ensure the physical and emotional well-being of the dog.

All Maplelane puppies are sold with a complete health guarantee. Your puppy has had a complete and thorough examination by our Veterinarian at the age of six weeks and is guaranteed to be in a good, clean state of health on departure from our home. You are advised to have your own veterinarian examine your new puppy within 72 hours of departure from our home.

If for any reason, the buyer is not satisfied with the puppy within this three day period you may return it to our home (at the purchaser's expense), provided the puppy is in the same condition as when sold. The buyer will receive a replacement puppy from the next litter whelped at our home, to be decided upon by the breeder, or a full refund. All veterinary bills after departure from our home, no matter what the reason, including the three day period are the responsibility of the purchaser.

MAPLELANE GOLDEN RETRIEVERS WILL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING THREE YEAR INCLUSIVE GUARANTEE ON EACH PUPPY SOLD :

- 1) Free of hereditary eye cataracts.
- 2) To be of sound temperament upon departure from our home.
- 3) Free of congenital heart disease, as determined by and ultrasound.
- 4) Free of hip dysplasia, as per the following terms:
 - A) the dog must not be more than 10 pounds overweight as determined by a veterinarian.
 - B) there will be no cash refund unless surgery is required and completed.

If your dog shows any of the above faults in this 2 year period, and suitable evidence has been produced, the following terms are available.

One half of the original purchase price returned or a free puppy from the next available litter of the breeders choice. In this situation, the purchaser shall keep their original puppy and all vet bills pertaining to the ailment are the responsibility of the purchaser. If the purchaser does not want to keep the original puppy and wants to return it, then the cash settlement becomes null and void.

If for any reason, the buyer wishes to sell, trade, donate, give away, co-own, euthanize or part with their dog at any time, they agree to notify the breeder and give the breeder first opportunity to re-purchase the dog for a negotiable sum.

All puppies leaving our home do so on a standard Canadian Kennel Club Non-Breeding Contract. This will be lifted when the breeder is satisfied that the following conditions have been met.

- 1) free of hip dysplasia as certified by OVC or OFA
- 2) free of hereditary eye disease as certified by a canine Ophthalmologist
- 3) thyroid and VWD blood test negative
- 4) heart check
- 5) obtain a CKC recognized title
- 6) to be of sound temperament and a good representative of the breed

In the case of bitches, the non-breeding contract will not be lifted before the age of 2. In males it may be lifted at 18 months.

Unless otherwise discussed with the breeder, bitches are to be spayed by the age of 6 months, and the dogs are to be neutered by 18 month of age..

The breeder reserves the right to use any male dog bred by them for stud service to any bitch owned by the breeder. This privilege will be supplied on a no charge basis. This being achieved after the lifting of the non-breeding contract.

Throughout the dog's lifetime, it is the responsibility of the purchaser to forward copies of any clearances or titles obtained for the breeder's records.

It should be noted that all the above guarantees, clauses and conditions are a binding agreement between the breeder and the purchaser. Any forfeiture, neglect or failure to comply on the part of either party could result in legal action being taken. In the case of the purchaser failing to adequately provide for the dog in any way as stated herein, or the breeder discovers abuse in any form, gives the breeder the right to reclaim and repossess the dog with no financial attachment.
